Any operations involving open flames or producing heat and/or sparks require a hot work permit. This includes, but is not limited to, brazing, cutting, grinding, soldering, thawing, and welding. All hot work precautions should be implemented per National Fire Protection Code 51B.

Remove flammable and combustible material where possible. Otherwise, protect with fire blankets, guards or metal shields		
Cover all wall and floor openings.		
WORK ON WALLS OR CEILINGS		
Move combustibles away from other side of wall.		
WORK IN CONFINED SPACES		
Clean confined onfined spaces of all combustibles. (e. g., grease, oil, flammable vapors).		
Purge containers of flammable liquids/vapors. Follow confined space guidelines.		
WORK IN CONFINED SPACES		
Fire watch will be provided for 30 minutes.

#### **AFTER WORK: (including any coffee or lunch breaks)**

Fire watch is supplied with an multipurpose extinguisher, extinguishers are located throughout the work area.

Fire watch is trained in the use of this equipment and familiar with the location of sounding alarm.

Fire watch may be required for opposite side of walls, aboce and below floors and ceilings.

#### **OTHER PRECAUTIONS TAKEN:**

Confined space permit is required.

Are other occupants protected from heat, smoke or potential fire? Proper PPE is worn by all personnel.

Interlocks on conveyors or process piping are controlled, i.e., closed or shut off.
